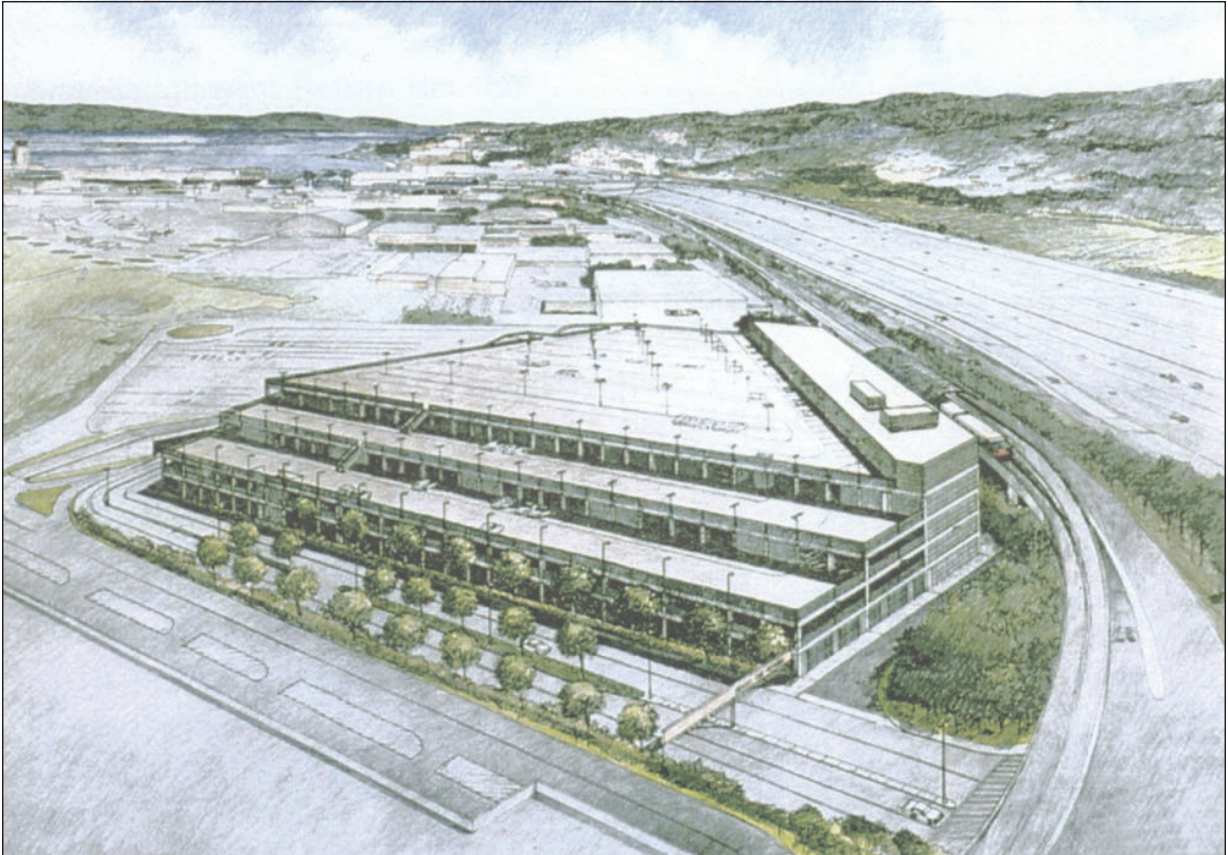




Rental Car Facility Development

San Francisco International Airport



Consolidated Rental Car Garage

IN December 1998, the San Francisco Airport Commission opened the first project in the San Francisco International Airport master plan—the consolidated rental car facility. Leigh Fisher Associates was retained in 1996 to assist Airport staff in (1) coordination of the rental car facility requirements for design of the facility, (2) development and implementation of the methodology for the space allocation and selection process, and (3) project coordination on behalf of the rental car companies.

Leigh Fisher Associates provided ongoing assistance to Airport staff, the project consultants, and the participating rental car companies to ensure the timely completion of the Airport's

core and shell construction, the common area tenant work, and the proprietary construction improvements.

The five-story garage, with its fuel wash and vehicle storage facilities on a 22-acre site, is the largest consolidated rental car facility in the United States.
